We love Karen deeply, and are very thankful she will continue to be an important part of this ministry. Over the years, Ron talked to me often about leading this ministry when he could no longer. He would always say to me, "Stephen, I want you to do this. I'm not going to be here forever."

Since Ron's unexpected passing, I have hesitated to be the new leader in part because of a call to a new ministry assignment, but mostly because I have been fearful of not living up to the high standard that Ron set. However, on May 11, 2021 I heard a clear call from the Lord while reading 2 Samuel 9 and the account of David and Mephibosheth. David was certainly a busy man. And yet, David took time to care for someone who had experienced a tragedy in his life that was beyond his control. I heard God say, "Stephen, I have blessed you in order to be a blessing. Besides, this is MY work not yours! I just need you to be a willing vessel." I immediately contacted Karen and told her that my answer, after much delay, was "yes." In May of 2021, our Board of Directors unanimously affirmed this as God's will, and the official transition took place in October 2021. Please see the
