Recently, I received a thank-you letter from a married ministerial student that said the following – "We received your gift and we praise God for you and your ministry! Your gift came at just the right time because we had just come into a time of extreme financial difficulty. It was so tumultuous that my husband even began to question his calling. My husband asked the Lord for a sign that He wanted him to continue in ministry, and your gift arrived the very next day!" I get these kind of notes regularly as God continues to use His people through Parson's Pantry to meet His needs in His time. Just this year we have been able to provide \$72,875.00 to help Pastors, Widows of Pastors, and Married Ministerial Students in times of crisis and extreme need.

The work of Parson's Pantry is more URGENT than ever. According to the SBC 2023 Ministry report, seminary enrollment numbers are down 21% year over year. In addition, according to Barna Research, the median age of pastors in America has risen from 44 in 1992 to 54 in 2022. Also, the number of pastors over 65 has tripled in that time period. With less pastors preparing for ministry, we cannot afford to see a single one fall out of the process. Moreover, as more pastors carry a heavier load longer than ever, they need our help more than ever as they continue to carry forth the message of the Gospel.
